Endeavour 32

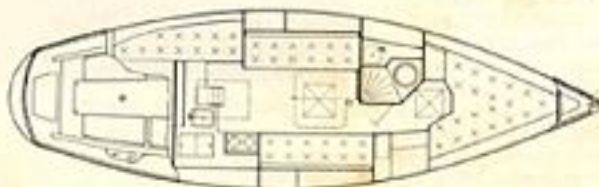
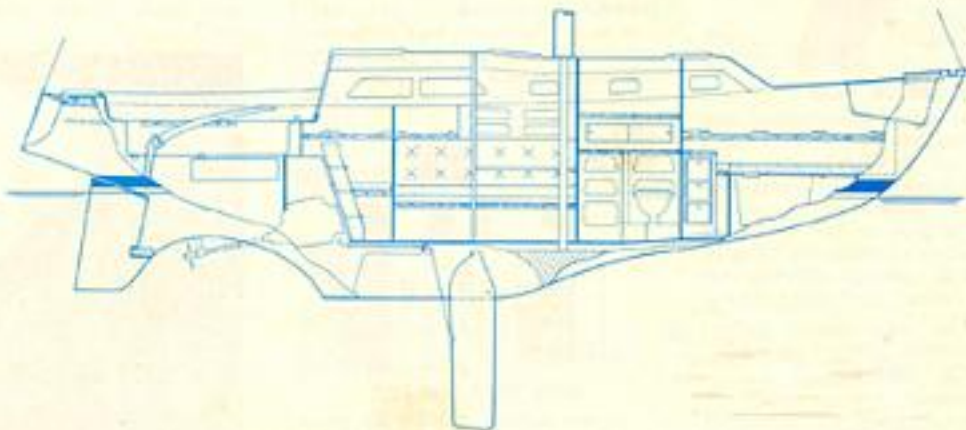
Here is a comfortable cruising sailboat for the occasional yacht club racer. Her shoal draft keel-centerboard hull is easily driven on and off the wind, and her roomy cockpit and uncluttered decks make sail handling safe, convenient and comfortable.

Down below she takes advantage of her full beam to provide spacious accommodations for five with 6'4" head room! In addition to a two burner stove with oven, there are numerous drawers and cabinets for storage, and extended counter space including a matched butcher block cutting board that doubles as a heat shield over the stove. A deep well ice chest, stainless steel sink and foot operated sink pump are all standard.

Decorator fabrics in earth tones are used on the mattress covers and to accent the carpeting and drapes. Private head includes a vanity with sink, mirror and lighting.

The Endeavour 32 will be a limited production, quality sailboat at a realistic price. Her national debut will be at the Annapolis Sailboat Show this fall, but you can find models already at dealers.
